The Native American Law Internship Program is a great opportunity for law students to gain hands-on experience dealing with everyday legal issues in Indian Country. In addition, the Program exposes interns to unique areas of tribal law and tribal court, complex areas of Federal Indian law, and long-term projects involving strategic planning and economic development.

Interested law students must submit an application by Friday, March 22nd by 5p.m. PST. Internship applications should include:

1. Writing sample
2. Law school transcript
3. Resume
4. Cover letter
